Math

We are continuing chapter 27, Customary Measurement. Your child needs to put in study time at home to memorize common measurement conversions. (i.e. the number of inches in a foot or the number of ounces in a cup.) Many of these can be found in the math book or in the back of his/her agenda. We are using flash cards in the classroom. This may be beneficial for your child at home. You can have your child create his/her own flash cards using 3x5 cards. The chapter test will be on Thursday, March 30th.
